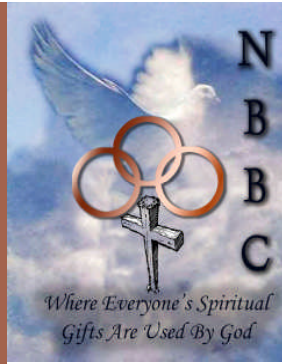

But now we see not yet all things put under him.)* <sup>9</sup> *But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honour; that he by the grace of God should taste death for every man.* Hebrews 2:6-9 (KJV)

**Pastor's Heart "The Answer"**

It makes sense to address a question to the person thought to know the right response or answer. However, many times as people, we tend to seek the answer from someone that has nothing to do with what we need and may not even have a clue. The Bible gives an account of a rich young ruler that after listening to the teachings of Jesus asked a question. The question was directed to Jesus, which makes sense; no one could answer the question better than the teacher himself could. <sup>16</sup> And, behold, one came and said unto him, Good Master, what good thing shall I do, that I may have eternal life? <sup>17</sup> And he said unto him, **Why callest thou me good? there is none good but one, that is, God: but if thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments.** <sup>18</sup> He saith unto him, Which? Jesus said, **Thou shalt do no murder, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness,** <sup>19</sup> **Honour thy father and thy mother: and, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself** <sup>20</sup> The young man saith unto him, All these things have I kept from my youth up: what lack I yet? <sup>21</sup> Jesus said unto him, **If thou wilt be perfect, go and sell that thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come and follow me.** <sup>22</sup> But when the young man heard that saying, he went away sorrowful: for he had great possessions. Matthew 19:16-22 (KJV)
